The school will serve as a model institution to showcase best practices and innovative approaches that significantly contribute to enhanced school governance, improved student outcomes, and strengthened community engagement.

The school shall prepare a 3–5-minute video presentation featuring:

- School profile and overview of SBM framework
- Description of key PPAs with innovations and best practices
- Status updates and impact of these initiatives
- Testimonials from school leaders, teachers, students, and community partners

Visual aids such as photos, video clips, charts, and infographics are encouraged to enhance the presentation.

Consent must be obtained from all individuals featured in the video to comply with privacy and ethical standards.

The video should be clear with good audio-visual quality in MP4 File format.

- Use clear, engaging narration or speaker presentation.
- · Incorporate visuals: photos, video clips, data charts, and infographics.
- · Include short interviews or voice clips for authenticity.
- · Maintain a positive and inspiring tone.

4. Technical Quality

- Ensure clear audio and good lighting.
- Steady camera work and good framing.
