In view of the continuing weather disturbances and other incidents affecting school operations, the Public Affairs Service (PAS) is requesting the support of all Regional and Division Information Officers (RIOs and DIOs) in providing timely and complete updates on class suspension announcements within your respective areas.

To ensure the accuracy of information being communicated to the public and media, please send real-time updates on class suspensions to the PAS-RIOs and DIOs Facebook Group Chat as soon as the advisory is available. These updates must include the following information:

- Reason for suspension (e.g., LPA, flooding, power interruption, local holiday)
- Alternative modality adopted, if applicable (e.g., modular, online)
- Name of the city/municipality/province
- Specific schools or levels affected (e.g., Pre-school to SHS, ALS, or all levels)

Kindly coordinate closely with your respective Local Government Units and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Officers to verify and validate suspension announcements before dissemination.

We emphasize the importance of accurate and consistent communication with the public, especially during emergency situations. The support of the RIOs and DIOs is crucial in helping DepEd manage public expectations and ensure learner safety.
