REGIONAL BERF BASIC/ACTION RESEARCH QUALIFIERS**




In line with the preparations for the 2026 Regional Basic Education Research Fund (BERF) submission, the Division of Aklan, through the Planning and Research Section, will conduct a Technical Assistance (TA) and Feedback Session for all regional qualifiers. This activity also serves as an opportunity to recognize and congratulate the qualifiers for their achievement.
2. The session aims to provide essential guidance and constructive feedback on research proposals to ensure compliance with BERF requirements and to further enhance the quality of submissions to the Regional Office.

District Research Coordinators are encouraged to conduct local TA sessions to assist these qualifiers in ensuring compliance for proposal approval. A separate memorandum will be issued to announce the deadline for submission of proposals.
6. Traveling expenses of participants shall be charged against the schools' available local funds, subject to existing budgeting, procurement, accounting, and auditing rules and regulations.
