Attached is the letter and the Sangguniang Panlalawigan Resolution No. 079 – 2025 from the Sangguniang Panlalawigan regarding Resolution No. 079-2025. This resolution urges strict compliance by Educational Institutions in the Province of Aklan with the mandate to excuse Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) Officials from attending classes when they are present at SK Meetings, Sangguniang Bayan, and Sangguniang Panlalawigan Sessions. This is a privilege prescribed by Republic Act No. 10742, or the SK Reform Act, as amended by Republic Act No. 11768, and implemented by the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) – National Youth Commission (NYC) Joint Memorandum Circular No. 01, series of 2025, as stipulated in the letter.

To align with the Department of Education's policy of no disruption of classes, schools should implement a modular mode of education for Sangguniang Kabataan officials.

RESOLUTION NO. 079-2025

“A RESOLUTION URGING STRICT COMPLIANCE BY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS IN THE PROVINCE OF AKLAN TO THE MANDATE ON EXCUSING SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN (SK) OFFICIALS FROM ATTENDING CLASSES WHEN ATTENDING SK MEETINGS, SANGGUNIANG BARANGAY SESSIONS, AND AS APPLICABLE, SANGGUNIANG BAYAN AND SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN SESSIONS, AS PRIVILEGE PRESCRIBED BY REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10742, OR THE SK REFORM ACT, AS AMENDED BY REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11768 AND IMPLEMENTED BY THE COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION (CHED) - NATIONAL YOUTH COMMISSION (NYC) JOINT MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 01, SERIES OF 2025”

WHEREAS, Section 16 (a)(3) of the SK Reform Act, or, Republic Act No. 10742, as amended by Republic Act No. 11768, Privileges of the Sangguniang Kabataan Officials provides that: "All Sangguniang Kabataan Officials in good standing, whether elected or appointed, shall during their incumbency: Be excused from attending their regular classes, if they are currently enrolled in any school, while attending their regular or special Sangguniang Kabataan meetings, and the Sangguniang Kabataan sessions, in the case of the Sangguniang Kabataan chairperson. A certification of attendance shall be issued by the Sangguniang Kabataan secretary attested by the Sangguniang Kabataan chairperson and duly noted by the Punong Barangay and shall be submitted to the concerned institution as proof of attendance. In the case of the Sangguniang Kabataan Secretary, the Sangguniang Kabataan chairperson shall issue the certification duly noted by the Punong Barangay. In the case of the Sangguniang Kabataan chairperson, the barangay Secretary shall issue the certification of attendance duly noted by the Punong Barangay. Any person who shall falsely certify as to the attendance of any Sangguniang Kabataan official shall be criminally and administratively liable;"

WHEREAS, to implement the mandate under the SK Reform Act, or RA No. 10742, as amended by RA No. 11768, the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) and the National Youth Commission (NYC) issued Joint Memorandum Circular No. 01, Series of 2025, repealing CHED-NYC JMC No. 01, Series of 2019, embodying the Revised Guidelines on the Privileges Granted To Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) Officials Pursuant To Section 16(a)(2) and (3) under the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA No. 10742, as Amended by RA No. 11768;


WHEREAS, while the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Aklan has yet to receive confirmed reports on possible violations by educational institutions against this statutorily mandated privilege of the SK Officials, this August Body was prompted to enact this resolution as reminder to school authorities, or heads and administrators of secondary and tertiary learning institutions.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It RESOLVED, As It Is Hereby RESOLVED, By The Sangguniang Panlalawigan Of The Province Of Aklan In Session Duly Assembled: TO URGE STRICT COMPLIANCE BY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS IN THE PROVINCE OF AKLAN TO THE MANDATE ON EXCUSING SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN (SK) OFFICIALS FROM ATTENDING CLASSES WHEN ATTENDING SK MEETINGS, SANGGUNIANG BARANGAY SESSIONS, AND AS APPLICABLE, SANGGUNIANG BAYAN AND SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN SESSIONS, AS PRIVILEGE PRESCRIBED BY REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10742, OR THE SK REFORM ACT, AS AMENDED BY REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11768 AND IMPLEMENTED BY THE COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION (CHED)-NATIONAL YOUTH COMMISSION (NYC) JOINT MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 01, SERIES OF 2025.
