

1. The Philippine Normal University (PNU), in partnership with the Department of Education (DepEd) through the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP), will conduct the Completion Ceremony for the Linking Standards and Quality Practice (LiSQuP) Program as part of PNU's 117th Commencement Exercises on 9-10 September 2025 at Tent City, Manila Hotel.

2. The Completion Ceremony will be conducted per cluster according to the following schedule:

	Cluster 2	2:00 PM to 6:00 PM
September 10, 2025 Wednesday	Cluster 3	8:00 AM to 12:00 PM

3. The **official list of completers**, as identified by PNU, shall be released through a separate advisory. PNU will confer postgraduate certificates to scholars who have met the following minimum unit requirements in specialization and elective courses, as outlined in the Outcome-Based Graduate Teacher Education Curriculum (OBGTEC 3.0):

- Master's Level (MA): at least 15 units
- Doctorate Level (PhD): at least 18 units

In the context of PNU-LiSQuP, a (post)graduate certificate serves as a credential that verifies a scholar's content knowledge in their area of specialization.

Meanwhile, a (post)graduate diploma will be awarded to scholars who, in addition to fulfilling the requirements in specialization and elective courses, have also completed the following minimum number of units in core courses:

- Master's Level (MA): at least 15 units
- Doctorate Level (PhD): at least 12 units

Core courses must include subjects in the following areas:

- Philosophy (ED701/ED801)
- Research (ED702, ED703, ED704, ED804, ED803, ED805)
- Innovation (PED701, PED702, INV701, INV702, ED802)

A (post)graduate diploma affirms a scholar's mastery of pedagogy, research, and innovation within the context of the PNU-LiSQuP program.

4. Transportation, per diem, and other incidental expenses of scholars who receive confirmation to attend the ceremony shall be charged against School/Division MOOE and other local funds, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations. However, this provision excludes any guests they may bring along, which means their expenses will not be covered.

5. Regional Offices shall have the authority to determine and approve the appropriate duration of travel for participants, particularly for those who require extended travel time due to distance or other logistical considerations.

6. LiSQuP scholars who have resigned from or have been separated from the Department of Education (DepEd) by any means will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony or receive their postgraduate certificate or diploma unless they have fully settled their financial obligations with DepEd, in accordance with OM-OUHROD-NEAP-2023-0601, titled **Non-Completion of Linking Standards and Quality Practice (LiSQuP) Scholarship Program**.

7. One (1) representative per Regional Office—either the Regional Director, Assistant Regional Director, NEAP-HRDD Chief, or the Regional LiSQuP Focal Person—is expected to attend both scheduled clusters' completion ceremonies. Transportation, per diem, and other incidental costs shall be charged against Regional Local Funds, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
