**DISTRICT TRAINING OF TUTORS AND SCHOOL LEADERS ON THE ACADEMIC RECOVERY AND ACCESSIBLE LEARNING (ARAL) PROGRAM**

1. In line with the implementation of the Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Program, this office urged the District to conduct a training for the ARAL Program to all ARAL tutors and School Heads. Schedule and other information are indicated in Enclosure No. 01.
2. The objectives of this activity are the following:
  - a) to understand the role and responsibilities of the ARAL tutors;
  - b) to equip them with teaching techniques and appropriate teaching strategies on reading according to the learning needs of the learners;
  - c) to manage instruction with inclusivity, by catering learners regardless of gender and disabilities.
3. Number of participants by district is found in the stated enclosures.
4. The expenses for food and materials for the training shall be charged against the downloaded Program Support Funds (PSF) for the Implementation of the ARAL Program from the FY 2025 Current of the Basic Education Curriculum, be downloaded to the identified IU Schools. Travel, venue and incidental expenses shall be charged against other eligible source of funds (MOOE, SEF and other local funds), subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.



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
