

What is NaMMAT?

The **National Merchant Marine Aptitude Test** is a standardized test that evaluates the foundational skills of students applying for the Bachelor of Science in Marine Engineering or the Bachelor of Science in Marine Transportation programs.

Approved by the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) and administered by the Center for Educational Measurement, Inc. (CEM), it **measures readiness for maritime education and future seafaring roles** rather than mastery of specific subjects. The test is provided **free of charge** for those who will take it and is required for programs leading to certification as Officers-In-Charge of a Navigational or Engineering Watch.

Registration Period: Sept. 24 - Oct. 15, 2025 | Testing Date in Iloilo City: October 25, 2025

- Senior High School graduates
- Current Senior High School students in their graduating year
- Those who have completed some college-level courses

STEPS ON HOW TO REGISTER

1. Create an account using a valid email here:
<https://www.cem-inc.org.ph/nammatt/user/register>
2. Verify email address.
3. Login to the online portal and complete your online registration using valid identification.
4. Edit registration details, if necessary, using **EDIT REGISTRATION** link found under Online Options in the website.
5. Check email (e.g., inbox, SPAM, and junk folder) or NaMMAT online account for the NaMMAT Registration Form and Exam Permit. (available at least 2 days before your actual test day)

TEST DAY INSTRUCTIONS

WHAT SHOULD I BRING ON TEST DAY?

- Valid physical ID (school or government-issued)
- NaMMAT Examination Permit
- 3-4 sharpened No. 2/HB pencils with erasers
- Transparent bag for essentials (wallet, keys, meds, water, light snacks)

OTHER IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- Complete both parts of the exam; stay until all materials are collected
- Failure to appear or complete = registration forfeited
- Test is confidential; sharing or copying answers is prohibited
