SUBJECT: 35th BSP AKLAN COUNCIL INVITATIONAL JAMBOREE

1. We are pleased to announce the holding of the 35th BSP Aklan Council Invitational Jamboree on February 8-12, 2026 at Naile, Ibajay, Aklan.
2. Qualified to attend are as follows:
 - A. Scouts must be:
 - Currently registered, Boy (9 to 12 years old) & Senior Scouts (12 to 18 years old) physically fit as certified by a physician and with parent's permit.
 - B. Scouters must be:
 - Currently registered, a graduate of Basic Training Course, physically fit as certified by a physician and have good moral character.
3. Activity Fee:
JAMBOREE FEE – Four Hundred Pesos (P 400.00) for Boy Scouts/Senior Scouts

Activity Fee will be used to defray expenses for camp facilities, materials and equipment for activities, food of staff, certificates and other incidental expenses. The registration fee and travelling expenses are chargeable against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
4. Each District is encouraged to maximize the participation to come up the 2,000 participants.
5. Food Provision. Contingent must be responsible for their own food and other basic requirements sufficient for the entire duration of the camp, manage their respective Camp Kitchen / Commissary and maintain sanitation and cleanliness.
6. Transportation, Logistics and Equipment. Contingents shall be responsible for arranging their own transportation and camping gadgets/equipment.
7. Attendance of Teacher / Adult Leaders to the 35th BSP Aklan Council Invitational Jamboree shall be on official business.
8. Service Credits: Registered Adult Leaders will be granted service credits for services rendered on Saturday and Sunday.
9. Pre-registration of participants will not be later than January 23, 2026.
10. Full support, cooperation and immediate dissemination of this Circular are desired.
