**GUIDELINES IN THE CONDUCT OF SY 2025-2026 AKLAN PROVINCIAL
ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION MEET**

1. The conduct of the **SY 2025-2026 Aklan Provincial Athletic Association Meet** will be on December 14-17, 2025, Aklan Sports Complex, Calangcang, Makato, Aklan, with the theme: "*Aklan, Akone: Eak-ang sa Kadaeag-an*".

2. The activity aims to:

- a. identify outstanding student-athletes who will represent the province in the higher-level competitions;
- b. promote sportsmanship, discipline, and camaraderie among learners through fair and competitive athletic events; and,
- c. support the holistic development of learners and strengthen the implementation of the School Sports Development Program.

3. There are six (6) units competing, to wit:

- Unit I - Altavas, Batan, and New Washington
- Unit II - Banga, Balete, Libacao, and Madalag
- Unit III - Lezo, Malinao, Makato, and Numancia
- Unit IV - Buruanga, Malay, Nabas, and Tangalan
- Unit V - Kalibo I and Kalibo II
- Unit VI - Ibajay I and Ibajay II

4. The competing units' official colors are the following:

- Unit I - Dominant color: Royal blue with Gold and White
- Unit II - Dominant color: Aqua Blue with White and Black
- Unit III - Dominant color: Maroon with Gold and White
- Unit IV - Dominant color: Gold with White and Black
- Unit V - Dominant color: White with Yellow and Blue
- Unit VI - Dominant color: Green with Yellow

5. There are three (3) sports categories to be played: Regular Sports, Demonstration Sports, and Paralympics.

6. For the Dancesport competition, unit delegation must send two (2) pairs of athletes of the Latin American Category and two (2) pairs for the Modern Standard Category.

7. The **Modified Winners-Takes-All policy** shall be adopted for all team sports (Basketball, Baseball, Softball, Football, Futsal, Sepak Takraw, and Volleyball) in accordance with the 2025 Palarong Pambansa Memorandum No. OM-OUOPS-2025-05-00833, s. 2025.

8. The submission of sports credentials will be on December 1-6, 2025. The deadline for compliance with credentials is on December 8-9, 2025. Ocular inspection and interviews with athletes, coaches, and chaperones are scheduled for December 10-12, 2025.

9. Technical officials who have been accredited by DepEd or their respective NSAs shall be given preference to officiate in the Provincial Meet.

10. All School Heads are required to ensure the participation of Technical Officials and Committee Members whose names appear in the attachment (see Enclosures 5 and 6 for reference). In the event that the Technical Officials and Committee Members cannot attend, the School Head must submit a written justification to the Schools Division Office of Aklan explaining the reason for non-attendance.

11. Consistent with DepEd's existing policies and guidelines in resolving protests on game technicalities of any sports event, complaints should be in written form and based on the protest procedure by event established by the technical committee.

12. To add color during the parade and highlight outstanding performance among the delegations, there will be three major awards for garnering the highest number of medals: Overall Champion, First Runners-up, and Second Runners-up. The Special Awards are: Best in Saludo, Best in Uniform, Biggest Delegation, Most Disciplined Delegation, Best Billeting School, Best School Sports Publication, Most Clean, Green, and Eco-Friendly Delegation, and Best Jingle.

13. Grades of pupil/student-athletes who will be participating in all levels of sports competition shall be given due consideration for the absences that they will incur during training sessions and in the competition proper. They are competing and representing their school, district, and unit; hence, they deserve the necessary academic support from the school authorities by arranging make-up/remedial classes which may include Alternative Delivery Modes (ADM) to ensure that they can cope with their lessons and subject area requirements.

14. Every unit must have a team of sports journalists to compose a Unit School Sports Publication using the unit's publication name. There will be a contest for the

Best School Sports Publication. This will be handled by the Division Elementary and Secondary School Paper Advisers Association (DESSPAA).

15. School officials and teachers who will serve in the 2025 Aklan Provincial Athletic Association Meet as accredited technical officials or members of the different working committees shall be granted service credits according to the provisions of DepEd Order No.53, s. 2003 titled "Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers" and other existing Department of Budget and Management (DBM)/Civil Service Commission (CSC) laws.

16. Non-Teaching Personnel of the all districts may witness the Opening Ceremony of the said event.

17. The conduct of the sports event shall adhere to the existing Guidelines on Health and Safety Protocols, Learner Rights and Protection, and Disaster Risk Reduction Management as stipulated in Enclosure No. 3 of DepEd Memorandum No.005, s. 2023 titled Conduct of 2023 Palarong Pambansa.

18. Expenses incurred by athletes, coaches, assistant coaches, chaperons, and DepEd officials in the attendance and conduct of these activities are chargeable against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

**2025 Provincial Athletic Association Meet
General Guidelines and Implementing Rules**

I. Legal Bases

The implementing rules, policies, and guidelines for the conduct of the 2025 Aklan Provincial Athletic Meet are found in the following:

- a. Memorandum OUOPS 20240-05-00946, "Establishment of the Learner Rights and Protection Desk and Implementation of Learner Rights and Protection Guidelines in the Conduct of Sports Events"
- b. MEMORANDUM OM-OUOPS-2025-05-01337 "Guidelines on the Eligibility of Athletes in the Division, Regional, and National Level for the Palarong Pambansa
- c. DepEd Memo no. 041, s. 2025, Conduct of the 2025 Palarong Pambansa
- d. DepEd Memorandum No. 77, s. 2017, "Clean, Green, Healthy, Organized and Eco Friendly 2017 Palarong Pambansa"
- e. Republic Act 11313, Safe Spaces Act or Bawal Bastos Law
- f. Republic Act 10588. entitled "An Act Institutionalizing the Conduct of the Palarong Pambansa and Appropriating Funds Therefor";
- g. DepEd Memorandum No. 95, s. 2015 "Amending the Age Eligibility and Other Requirements of Athletes in the Palarong Pambansa in Light of the Implementation of Republic Act (RA) No.10533, otherwise known as the "Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013"
- h. DepEd Memorandum No. 103, s. 2015 titled "Dissemination of Republic Act (RA) No. 10676 - An Act Protecting the Amateur Nature of Student-athletes in the Philippines by Regulating the Residency Requirement and Prohibiting the Commercialization of Student-athletes;
- i. DO 23, s. 2016 – School Calendar for School Year 2016-2017 Amended by DO 29, s. 2016 – Amendment to DepEd Order No. 23, s. 2016 (School Calendar for School Year 2016-2017)
- j. DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012. "DepEd Child Protection Policy"; and,
- k. DO. No. 5, s. 2016, "Implementing Guidelines on the Integration of Gulayan sa Paaralan, Solid Waste Management, and Tree Planting under the National Greening Program".



II. Ground Rules

- a. The Tournament Director (TD) of each event shall prepare the ground rules to be presented to the technical officials/coaches for revision and approval during the solidarity meeting.
- b. All parties must duly sign the approved ground rules by event, which must be strictly followed.
- c. All units will be furnished with a copy of the approved ground rules.

III. Participating Teams

- a. The participating teams shall be the following;

Unit	Unit Composition
I	Altavas, Batan, New Washington
II	Balete, Banga, Libacao, Madalag
III	Lezo, Makato, Malinao, Numancia
IV	Buruanga, Malay, Nabas, Tangalan
V	Kalibo I, Kalibo II

- b. Coaches/chaperons/athletes must be duly screened and found qualified by the eligibility committee. In addition, they must have participated in lower meets.
- c. Each team, should wear uniforms in their designated colors; to wit,

Unit	Designated Color
I	Dominant Color: Royal Blue with Gold and White
II	Dominant Color: Aqua Blue with White and Black
III	Dominant Color: Maroon with Gold and White
IV	Dominant Color: Gold with White and Black
V	Dominant Color: White with Yellow and Blue
VI	Dominant Color: Green and Yellow

- d. All participating units' uniform are required to participate in the parade carrying their banners for identification.

IV. Mode of Competition

- a. The TD shall prepare the rules of the tournament.
- b. The tournament format for the team events Basketball, Volleyball, Baseball, Softball, Futsal, and Football shall follow the bracket system (east and west). The top two teams in each bracket will advance to the semi-finals (cross-over system (East rank 1 vs West rank 2 and East rank 2 vs West rank 1)).

c. For individual events, single round-robin or knockout system may be followed. Changes in tournament format for team sports and individual/dual events shall be agreed upon during the solidarity meeting.

V. Schedule of Events

a. The schedule of games by event will be agreed and approved by the coaches and officiating officials during the solidarity meeting

b. All units should be furnished with a copy of the duly signed and approved schedule of games.

VI. Selection of Technical Officials

a. The Tournament Directors (TDs) should submit the list (encoded and placed in a long folder) of technical officials by event.

b. Technical officials shall meet the following requirements:

1. must have full know-how and expertise in officiating the event (accredited Technical Official in the Provincial Level):

2. shall have attended the division refresher course for technical officials and coaches.

3. shall have rendered services in the lower meets:

4. shall be physically fit:

5. shall exercise and demonstrate desirable values (fairness, good judgment, decisiveness, impartiality, competence, integrity, trustworthiness, among others: and

6. shall submit the following: medical certificate, appointment, and performance appraisal. Attach certificates of trainings attended.

c. Technical officials in uniform should participate in the parade and opening ceremonies.

d. All technical officials should be recommended based on their competence, trainings, experience, and level of accreditation by the tournament manager, district sports coordinator, School Head, and Public Schools District Supervisor (PSDS) to Education Program Supervisor (EPS)/Coordinator in-charge of Sports and be approved by the Schools Division Superintendent.

e. For Public Schools, all Technical Officials should be Regular Permanent, and with the consent/approval of the School Head. For Private Schools, a Certificate of Employment issued by the employer and signed by the Principal. He/she should be employed six (6) months before the Provincial Meet.

VII. Selection of Athletes and Coaches

a. The selection of athletes and coaches shall be stipulated in the ground rules of every event.

b. Each athlete is encouraged to play in one Sports Discipline.

c. The composition of the selection committee in choosing athletes and coaches per event is as follows:

1. Winning and losing coaches
2. Tournament director

d. To qualify for the WVRAA Meet, athletes and coaches shall have participated in the provincial meet, have been duly selected, and have met the standards set by the WVRAA.

e. Selected athletes shall signify his/her willingness to participate in the WVRAA Meet through a written parent's consent.

f. Failure to attend the training before the WVRAA Meet and failure to meet the deadline for submission of the documents shall automatically disqualify the athletes/coaches from joining the competition.

g. The winning coaches in the provincial meet must have basic training in the event to qualify to participate in the WVRAA Meet.

h. The coach shall meet the qualifications as stated in the DepEd Memorandum No. 43, S. 2016, and Amendments made by the Palarong Pambansa Board.

i. The coach shall be willing to train athletes during the training period.

j. The coach shall attend the solidarity meeting and participate in the scheduled games. Failure to attend the solidarity meeting will automatically disqualify the team in the first game.

k. The coach must be physically fit and must observe proper decorum, the highest degree of professionalism, sportsmanship, and discipline.

l. In case the winning coach waives his/her right to coach the team, the executive committee shall decide who will coach.

VIII. Selection of Trainers for Regional Meet

The trainers shall:

- a. Have thorough knowledge and expertise on the skills and rules required by the game;
- b. be willing to train the athletes during the period of training; and,
- c. submit credentials just like the coaches.

IX. Selection of Chaperon

The chaperons shall:

- a. be DepEd employees;
- b. submit credentials as stated in the Paloro Eligibility Rules and Guidelines;
- c. have the know-how of the game;
- d. have the knowledge in the preparation of athletes' credentials;

- e. be willing to accompany the athlete(s) at the housing area during the training period; and
- f. be willing to assist the coach in the preparation of athletes' credentials.

X. Athletes' Credentials

- a. Athletes' credentials shall conform to the specifications stated in DepEd Memorandum Nos. 45, s. 2019.
- b. No Municipal Civil Registrar or NSO/PSA-issued live birth certificate, no play.
- c. All credentials shall be submitted to the Division Screening and Accreditation Committee (DSAC) on or before December 20, 2024.
- d. All athletes shall submit himself/herself for ocular inspection before the event proper. **No ocular inspection, No play.**

XI. Screening Committee (DepEd Memorandum No. 156, s. 2016)

- a. The Division Screening and Accreditation Committee (DSAC) shall consist of the following:
 - 1. The designated chairman by the SDS/EPS in charge of Sports.
 - 2. A representative from each participating Unit.
 - 3. The Division Physician and its Dentist.
- b. The Division Screening and Accreditation Committee accredits the eligibility of athletes, coaches, and chaperons in the Provincial Meet.
- c. The decision of DSAC is final.
- d. It submits all updated records of athletes to the records and documentation committee for safekeeping.

X. Protests

A. Protest on Technicalities

Protest on technicalities arising from the games including unsportsmanlike conduct of athletes/coaches/chaperones/trainers and supporters shall be resolved in the following manners;

- A.1 The Tournament Director concerned is empowered to conduct an on-the-spot investigation and decide immediately on any protest including unsportsmanlike conduct so as not to disrupt the progress of the games.
- A.2. The Tournament Secretary concerned shall record and keep in file the decisions of the Tournament Director signed and verified by them.
- A.3. If the parties are not satisfied with the decision of the Tournament Director, a formal written protest, signed by the coach concerned and noted by the head of the delegation, shall be filed with the Jury of Appeals not later than twelve (12) hours

after the incident. 7.4 No protest elevated to the Jury of Appeals shall be entertained if not compliant with number 7.3 and will outright be dismissed.

A.4. The Jury of Appeals shall convene within twenty-four (24) hours upon receipt and decide the protest.

A.5. The decision of the Jury is final and non-appealable. No Motion for Reconsideration would be entertained.

B. Protest on Eligibility

Eligibility requirements of athletes, coaches, and chaperones shall be guided by RA 10588, D.O. 43 s 2016 and its subsequent issuances including its rules and procedures on eligibility protest, to wit;

B.1. Protest shall be in writing and duly signed by the coach and noted by the Head of the Delegation and shall be filed before the start of the second game of the concerned team/athlete with the appropriate Screening and Accreditation Committee.

B.2 Protest filed by another person shall be automatically dismissed without prejudice of refiling the same upon compliance with the above-mentioned requirements.

B.3 The DSAC/RSAC may MOTU PROPIO conduct an investigation if there is an obvious truth or merit of the allegation questioning the eligibility of the athletes/coaches.

B.4 Protest shall be accompanied by an affidavit of witnesses and/or evidences to support thereof.

B.5 The protest shall be acted upon immediately by the DSAC/RSAC upon receipt thereof within twenty-four (24) hours.

B.6 The protestant shall have the burden of proof and shall provide necessary evidences (documentary/testimonials) otherwise the protest will be dismissed.

B.7 The DSAC/RSAC may also investigate complaint/s of misrepresentation, impersonation, and violations of a similar nature, for purposes of determining the eligibility of the athlete without prejudice to the filing of administrative and criminal actions against the person/s responsible thereto.

B.8 The DSAC/RSAC shall act on information of a violation of eligibility of athletes/coaches and take necessary actions even after the Regional Palaro. It shall determine the existence of a prima facie case.

B.9 Decision of the DSAC/RSAC shall be FINAL. No Motion for reconsideration shall be entertained and will be dismissed outright.

B.10 Appeal from the decision of the RSAC can be taken to the NSAC. No Appeal on eligibility protest shall be taken after the end of the WVRAA Meet.

XI. Violation of Code of Conduct Including Unsportsmanlike Conduct

1. Personnel of the Department, personnel of partner private schools, and personnel of partner LGU serving in whatever capacity during the duration of the school sports event shall be sanctioned according to these guidelines and the agreed ground rules.
2. Aside from the sanctions imposed under number 1, they may be suspended from participating in future school sports competitions in whatever capacity, the duration of which shall be one (1) to three (3) years depending on the gravity of the offense. Provided, that he/she shall suffer the penalty of perpetual disqualification from participating in any future school sports competition in whatever capacity in case of violations which are intentional and willful.
3. These sanctions shall be without prejudice to the filing of appropriate administrative, civil, and/or criminal charges against the erring officials and personnel in accordance with existing laws, rules, and regulations.
4. Further, immediate sanctions under their respective events ground rules/international rules shall be applied.
5. DepEd personnel not serving in any capacity during the school sports event but nonetheless participated as supporters/official delegation members, in case of violations, shall likewise be sanctioned.
6. The report or complaint of a violation of the code of conduct including unsportsmanlike conduct must be written, and signed by the complainant; and shall be filed within twelve (12) hours after the incident. The investigation by the Committee on Discipline and Dequorum (CDD) will be under the authority of the appropriate SDS/Regional Director.
7. For those incidents that are not covered by the ground rules or otherwise inapplicable, the Tournament Director shall write an incident report or narrative report together with their actions taken or sanctions imposed and to be submitted to the Jury of Appeals.
