DATE : December 2, 2025

The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Learning Systems Strand, shall conduct the **Monitoring of the Revised Kindergarten to Grade 10 and Strengthened Senior High School Curriculum** to evaluate and address emerging curriculum implementation gaps on **December 10 to 12, 2025**, within **Region VI**. The details of the venue will be announced through an advisory.

Specifically, the activity aims to:

1. Evaluate the relevance and effectiveness of the Strengthened SHS curriculum;
2. Assess teacher readiness and professional development needs;
3. Identify implementation challenges at the classroom, school, and system levels;
4. Gather stakeholder feedback to inform curriculum refinement; and
5. Recommend strategies for continuous curriculum enhancement and a seamless transition across grade levels.

Participants in this activity will include selected teachers and school leaders from schools offering the Revised K to 10 Curriculum and schools currently piloting the Strengthened Senior High School (SHS) Curriculum (Grade 11).

Regional Offices are requested to select their participants in accordance with the guidelines below:

1. **Selection of participating schools.** Due to venue limitations, only a limited number of schools implementing the Revised K to 10 Curriculum and pilot



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implementing the Strengthened SHS (Grade 11) will participate in the monitoring activities. The distribution of schools by region and school size is as follows:

Criteria for the Selection of Participants

Further, the following criteria shall be used for the selection of **teachers**:

- Must be a teacher from a public school implementing the Kindergarten to Grade 10 or the Strengthened SHS Curriculum;
- Must have a minimum of five (5) years of teaching experience in the relevant subject area and have handled classes under the Revised K to 10 Curriculum or Strengthened SHS Curriculum;
- Preferably holds a bachelor's degree aligned with the subject area or specialization; and



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- Must demonstrate collaboration, commitment, and the ability to provide comprehensive and constructive feedback.

Meanwhile, **school leaders** shall be selected based on the following criteria:

- Must be a school head or administrator from a public school implementing the Kindergarten to Grade 10 Curriculum or currently piloting the Strengthened SHS Curriculum;
- Must have at least three (3) years of experience in a school leadership role;
- Must demonstrate active involvement in curriculum implementation and school-based management;
- Must possess a strong track record in promoting instructional leadership, collaboration, and continuous improvement within the school; and
- Must be able to provide comprehensive and constructive feedback on curriculum implementation during the monitoring activity.
