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

The Schools Division shall ensure that learner-participants are provided with modules for the lessons missed, while teacher-coaches shall submit a substitution plan to ensure that classes are not disrupted during the conduct of these activities in compliance with DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2015, titled, *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith* and DepEd Order No. 3, s. 2024, titled, *Amendment to DepEd Order No. 022, s. 2023*.
5. The teachers involved in these activities are entitled to Service Credits for their services rendered during weekends and holidays but not exceed 15 days in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 titled *Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers*. On the other hand, non-teaching personnel shall be provided with Compensatory Time Off (CTO) for their services rendered during weekends and holidays as per *Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered*.


To support the participants' engagement, we kindly seek your assistance in the following:
