

I am Ednaly De Miguel De Jose of Numancia Integrated School, District of Numancia writing this letter to ask for permission to have a financial drive donation from the teachers in the Division of Aklan to augment the daily medication and continuous hospital bill of my premature baby who is currently admitted at Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) of Asia Pacific Medical Center.

I was admitted at the above-mentioned hospital last December 20, 2025 due to severe bleeding and signs of early labor and delivery. My doctor tried to stop my labor because it was too early to give birth, but December 21, 2025, the labor and bleeding did not subside and already life-threatening for me and the baby, resulting to urgent emergency Caesarian Section. I gave birth to my baby very premature. He was only 28 weeks Gestation equivalent to 7 months, that was why he needed to be confined in NICU for him to survive.

Now, my premature baby is still in the NICU and doing fine though he is still in an incubator and with oxygen support since his lungs is not yet fully developed, but he is fighting. Too small, too tiny, yet a fighter. His brave and courageous will to live are the reasons why I am also fighting. He is a wonderful gift that was given by our almighty. A new life who deserves to live and see the wonder of the earth. An innocent life that needs to be earned.

I am a teacher who has full of loan debts. My net take home pay is already insufficient reason that I cannot already have bigger loan amount. Now that I am in this critical situation, as one of the teachers in the Division of Aklan, I am hoping that my request for financial aid will be possible. I am hoping for your generosity and prayers for our little warrior, Mario Calixto De Miguel De Jose. Thank you very much.
