**PARTICIPATION OF THE WESTERN VISAYAS REGIONAL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (WVRAA) DELEGATION TO THE 2026 PALARONG PAMBANSA**

To: Schools Division Superintendents  
Presidents of State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities  
All Others Concerned

1. Relative to the conduct of the 2026 *Palarong Pambansa* to be held on **May 24 -31, 2026 in Agusan Del Sur**, this Office announces the official Western Visayas Regional Athletic Association (WVRAA) Delegation. The billeting quarters of the delegation will be at **Rosario Central Elementary School** and **Datu Lipus Makapandong National High School**, Poblacion, Rosario, Agusan Del Sur.
2. Attached as Enclosure 1 is the list of athletes with their corresponding coaches, assistant coaches, and chaperones. The Modified Winner-Take-All Policy in the seven (7) team sports (basketball, volleyball, football, futsal, sepak takraw, baseball, and softball) shall be implemented in the selection of athletes for this year's *Palarong Pambansa*.
3. For the measurable sports (Archery, Athletics, and Swimming), the herein list of WVRAA athletes will still be vetted with the qualifiers from other regional delegations. A separate Memorandum shall be issued once the final lists of athletes for these measurable sports are released by the *Palarong Pambansa* Secretariat.
4. To ensure the physical and emotional preparations of the athletes in this national sporting event, there shall be an in-house / concentration training for all the winning athletes, especially in team sports, in identified training venues within the Region to be supervised by the identified Head Coach of the delegation together with the Cluster Coaches and Supervising Coaches as members of the Games Management Committee. The list of the Games Management Committee and other Technical Working Groups is found in Enclosure 2 to this Memorandum.
5. For individual or pair events, they can adopt another scheme for their concentration training provided that designated schedule for critiquing and final coaching shall be included in the training design to be facilitated by the assigned Cluster and Supervising Coaches. The identified training centers

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for the in-house / concentration training of the various sports events are found in Enclosure 3 of this Memorandum. The athletes, coaches, assistant coaches, chaperones, and the members of the training management team are expected to report to the identified training center(s) in case of a centralized training scheme.

6. The Schools Division Offices, through their respective Division Sports Officers, shall facilitate the communication with their respective LGUs and other stakeholders of the needed resources for the in-house/concentration training of the athletes, coaches, and assistant coaches as well as the provision of their playing uniform and transportation fare from their point of origin to Agusan Del Sur and vice versa.

7. On the other hand, the Regional Office shall provide the parade uniforms of the athletes, assistant coaches, and chaperones and other TWG members as well as their food for the entire duration of the activity and other materials deemed necessary in the conduct of the 2026 *Palarong Pambansa*.

8. The Division Sports Officer (DSO) shall issue an advisory to their respective athletes, coaches, and assistant coaches regarding the schedule, scheme, and venue of the in-house training, using the template provided in Enclosure 4 of this Memorandum and duly signed by the Schools Division Superintendent. The Regional Management Team (RMT), together with the Monitoring and Evaluation Committee, the Head Coach, Cluster Coaches, and the supervising coaches, shall oversee the conduct of the in-house training to ensure that the proposed training design of the official coach is properly implemented. The **food of the supervising coaches for 20 days** shall be charged against the downloaded Program Support Fund for the conduct of the 2026 Regional Meet, while the food of the other monitoring teams and the travel expenses of all the participants shall be charged against their respective local funds.

9. All athletes, coaches, assistant coaches, chaperones, and the Regional Management Committee members shall bring two (2) pieces of 2x2 recent ID picture for the Palarong Pambansa ID which shall be provided by the Secretariat Committee and shall be used as means of verification for all the official WVRAA delegates during the entire duration of the 2026 *Palarong Pambansa*.

10. The expected date of departure of the WVRAA delegation to Agusan Del Sur will be on **May 15, 2026** and the expected arrival in the billeting schools will be on **May 17, 2026**, while the return trip to Region VI is scheduled on **May 30 - 31, 2026**. A pre-departure meeting of the WVRAA delegation with the Regional Management Team, Chairpersons and selected members of the Technical Working Committees, all members of the Games



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Management Committee with the coaches, assistant coaches, and chaperones shall be conducted on **May 11, 2026** in a venue within Iloilo City.

11. To ensure that all athletes are well taken care of, the **“carry all policy”** shall be strictly implemented to all official coaches. Should the official coach choose to stay outside the designated billeting school, he/she shall bring with him/her the athletes and the rest of the members of the team and assume full responsibility for the payment of the billeting facility. Provided further, that a written consent signed by the parent or guardian of the athlete shall be presented to permit this arrangement with the coach concerned.

12. The Regional Screening and Accreditation Committee (RSAC) shall start the preparation of the documents of the qualified athletes, coaches, assistant coaches, and chaperones on April 20 – 24, 2026 at the DepEd RO VI RELC Dormitory in preparation for the onsite **ocular inspection of the National Screening and Accreditation Committee (NSAC) on April 27 – 30, 2026**. The board and lodging of the selected RSAC members and the eight (8) NSAC members during the ocular inspection shall be shouldered by the concerned SDOs chargeable against their respective local/MOOE funds. The scanning of the documents of the qualified athletes, coaches, assistant coaches, and chaperones shall follow on May 4 - 8, 2026 at DepEd RO VI RELC Dormitory for submission to the NSAC. The meals and accommodation of the RSAC members during the preparation of the documents shall be charged against the Program Support Fund (PSF) to be downloaded by the *Palarong Pambansa* Board.

13. To promote environmental sustainability and responsible stewardship and to ensure the health and safety of the learners and personnel, the **ECo Champions Program** shall be implemented in the WVRAA delegation in the conduct of the 2026 *Palarong Pambansa* to be spearheaded by the DRRM and the Cleanliness and Beautification Committees. The implementation procedure of the ECo Champions Program and the health and safety checklist are found in Enclosures 5 and 6, respectively.

15. The teaching personnel involved in the activity are entitled to Service Credits for their services rendered in the entire duration of the activity but not to exceed 15 days in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 titled: "*Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers*". On the other hand, non-teaching personnel shall be provided with Compensatory Time Off (CTO) for their services rendered during weekends and holidays as per *Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered*. The grant of service credits and CTO to teaching and non-teaching personnel from the Divisions is delegated to their respective Schools Division Offices to expedite the processing subject to compliance with the necessary documents such as authority to travel, approved Daily Time Record (DTR), and the accomplishment report.

16. The travel expenses of the Regional Technical Working Committees shall be charged against the downloaded Program Support Fund for the conduct of the 2026 *Palarong Pambansa*. While the food of the participants, starting with **breakfast** on **May 16** until **dinner** on **May 31**, shall be provided by this Office, provided that the participants will travel with the Regional TWC members by boat to Agusan del Sur and back to Iloilo. Should a participant opt to travel by airplane, he/she shall shoulder his/her meals for the duration of the travel. Additionally, the per diem and other incidental expenses incurred by the participants shall be charged against their respective local funds, all subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

**IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL  
CONSERVATION (ECo) CHAMPIONS PROGRAM OF THE WVRAA  
DELEGATION IN THE 2026 PALARONG PAMBANSA**

**I. BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE**

The conduct of the 2026 *Palarong Pambansa* requires the establishment of a comprehensive environmental management mechanism due to the large influx of participants, temporary settlements, and intensive use of shared facilities. These conditions create significant challenges in waste management, sanitation, and environmental safety, which, if not properly addressed, may affect the health, security, and overall experience of the event.

In response, the Environmental Conservation (ECo) Champions Program is implemented as an integrated strategy to support sustainable event management. It is anchored on national policies on ecological solid waste management and disaster risk reduction, and is aligned with the Department of Education's commitment to safe, healthy, and resilient learning and event environments.

The program operationalizes three key components – the **Greening Project, Solid Waste Management, and Disaster Resilience**—to ensure that environmental protection measures are effectively carried out in the billeting schools of the WVRAA delegation. Through the active participation of the members of the delegation, the ECo Champions Program promotes shared responsibility, environmental discipline, and proactive risk reduction throughout the duration of the *Palarong Pambansa*.

**II. OPERATIONAL CONTEXT**

During the conduct of the 2026 *Palarong Pambansa*, the ECo Champions Program shall function as a frontline environmental management mechanism integrated with the DRRM, Accommodation, Cleanliness & Beautification, Health, and Security Committees to ensure:

- Clean, safe, and organized venues and billeting areas;
- Efficient solid waste management; and
- Environmentally responsible behavior of all delegates.



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### III. OBJECTIVES

- a. Implement effective **greening initiatives** through tree planting and vegetable nursery that reduce heat stress and improve environmental conditions in billeting areas.
- b. Ensure **efficient solid waste management** through strict segregation, reduction of waste, and proper disposal systems across all event sites.
- c. Strengthen **disaster resilience** by maintaining hazard-free environments and integrating environmental management into DRRM operations.

### IV. COVERAGE

Environmental Conservation (ECo) Champions Program shall be implemented throughout the duration of the 2026 *Palarong Pambansa* and shall apply to all members of the WVRAA delegation billeting areas and immediate surroundings.

### V. PROGRAM COMPONENTS AND IMPLEMENTATION

#### A. GREENING PROJECT

**Objective:** Promote environmental preservation and mitigation through active participation in greening activities.

**Strategies:**

- Participation in **tree planting activities** in coordination with the host region / schools (if scheduled).
- Establishment of **vegetable plant nursery** utilizing seeds generated from food preparation wastes for the delegation.
- Encouragement of **plant care or symbolic greening initiatives** within billeting areas.
- Adoption of a **“Clean and Green Billeting Area”** policy.
- Daily watering and maintenance schedules.

**Guidelines:**

- The Greening Project shall prioritize temporary and modular greening interventions suitable for short-term but intensive events.



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- All greening activities shall be coordinated with the DRRM, accommodation, facilities and maintenance committee to ensure safety, accessibility, and alignment with venue layouts.
- Only approved plant species and materials shall be used, prioritizing low-maintenance, non-toxic, and climate-appropriate plants.
- Use of reusable materials (e.g., tumblers, eco-bags) is highly encouraged
- Greening structures shall not obstruct evacuation routes, crowd flow, or emergency access points.
- Maintenance responsibility shall be clearly assigned per area through the designated ECo Champions Program coordinator.

## **B. SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT**

**Objective:** Ensure proper waste disposal and reduction of waste generation.

**Strategies:**

- Strict implementation of **waste segregation** (biodegradable, non-biodegradable, recyclable).
- Installation/designation of **color-coded bins** in billeting and activity areas.
- Establishment of Materials Recovery Facilities (**MRFs**).
- Establishment of designated **composting areas** for proper processing of food wastes.
- Practice of **“Clean As You Go” (CLAYGO)** at all times especially in the mess hall.

**Guidelines:**

- All delegates must segregate their wastes accordingly.
- No dishwashing personnel will be provided; all athletes and delegates are responsible for **washing their own eating utensils/plates**.
- Minimize the use of single-use plastics.
- Regular monitoring and inspection of waste disposal practices shall be conducted by the monitoring team.
- Wastes shall be minimized through reduction, reuse, and recycling practices.



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**Operational Controls:**

1. Littering is strictly prohibited in all event and billeting areas.
2. Wastes shall not be left overnight in open areas or corridors.
3. Food wastes shall be disposed of immediately to prevent pests and odors.

**C. DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT (DRRM)**

**Objective:** Ensure safety and preparedness of all delegates in case of emergencies.

**Strategies:**

- Conduct of **orientation on safety protocols** upon arrival.
- Participation in **earthquake and fire drills**, and other emergency simulations as scheduled.
- Identification of **emergency exits, assembly areas, and evacuation plans**.
- Keep **evacuation routes free from obstructions**.
- Maintain **clear and accessible evacuation routes** at all times.
- Support the implementation of **heat mitigation measures**, including shaded waiting areas and hydration access points.
- Assist in ensuring that waste materials do not accumulate near electrical lines or combustible areas.

**Guidelines:**

- All delegates must actively participate in drills and follow instructions from authorities.
- Each team shall assign a **Safety/DRRM Focal Person**.
- Emergency hotlines and contacts must be posted in visible areas.
- First aid kits should be readily available per team/unit.

**VI. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

**Delegation Officials/TWG Members:**

- Oversee overall implementation of the program.
- Ensure dissemination of guidelines to all members.



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**Coaches/Chaperones:**

- Monitor compliance of athletes.
- Reinforce discipline and participation.

**Athletes:**

- Practice and uphold all environmental and safety protocols.
- Act as **ECo Champions** in their respective teams.

**VII. MONITORING AND COMPLIANCE**

- Daily monitoring shall be conducted in billeting areas.
- Non-compliance may be reported to delegation officials for appropriate action.
- Recognition will be given to teams/ groups demonstrating exemplary practices.

**VIII. EFFECTIVITY**

These guidelines shall take effect immediately upon arrival of the WVRAA Delegation in Agusan del Sur and shall remain in force throughout the duration of the 2026 Palarong Pambansa.

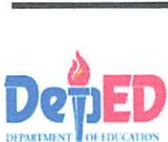

**WESTERN VISAYAS REGIONAL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (WVRAA)  
HOUSE RULES & CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE 2026 PALARONG PAMBANSA**

**I. General Principles**

1. All members of the WVRAA Delegation shall uphold **discipline, integrity, sportsmanship, and regional pride** in its participation in the Palarong Pambansa.
2. Respect for authority, teammates, opponents, officials, and host communities is mandatory.
3. The welfare, dignity, and rights of learners shall always be protected.

**II. House Rules**

**A. General Conduct**

1. All athletes, coaches, assistant coaches, chaperons, and TWG members must show the highest degree of politeness and respect to anyone.
2. The **Code of Conduct and Ethical Standards for Public Officials and Employees** shall be strictly followed.
3. Punctuality and promptness shall be observed during games, practices, and meetings.
4. All delegation members are required to join the parade, opening, and closing programs.
5. Wearing of official **Palarong Pambansa ID** at all times is mandatory to **all participants**.
6. Courtesy and respect must be observed in all interactions.

**B. Billeting and Accommodation**

7. Billeting rooms are exclusively for delegation members. Visitors are **not allowed** to stay inside any rooms in the billeting schools.
8. Parents/guardians may visit only during scheduled hours (**5:00–7:00 pm**) with prior arrangement from the Regional Management Team.
9. Rooms must be kept locked; keys must be left with the Security & Discipline Committee in-charge during scheduled games.
10. Lights, fans, faucets, and other fixtures must be turned off before leaving the room.
11. Drying of clothes must be done only in designated areas.
12. Transferring of beddings from one room to another without permission is prohibited.
13. Cleanliness and sanitation must be maintained at all times in quarters, comfort rooms, and other premises.
14. Occupants must ensure fixtures are intact upon check-out; damages are the responsibility of the assigned coach/chaperone.
15. **Waivers** must be secured for those staying outside billeting quarters, signed by the SDS.



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16. A **Clearance** must be secured a day before departure from the Secretariat Committee to be signed by the Chairperson of the Accommodation Committee, Mess and Food Committee, Regional Screening and Accreditation Committee and the Regional Management Committee and to be submitted to the Secretariat for filing.

**C. Health, Safety, Security and Discipline**

15. Daily blood pressure checks shall be conducted every morning and evening or before the departure to the playing venues.
16. Delegation members with medications must take them as prescribed by their physicians.
17. Health problems must be reported immediately to the Health & Safety Committee.
18. Smoking, vaping, drinking liquor, and gambling are strictly prohibited.
19. Curfew is set at **10:00 pm to 4:00 am**; lights off at 10:00 pm. Loud conversations beyond curfew are not allowed.
20. Coaches and chaperons must ensure athletes are properly accounted for at all times.
21. Permission to leave billeting areas outside scheduled games requires approval by the Regional Management Team.
22. **Pass slips** must be secured from the Secretariat and countersigned by the Regional Management Committee.

**D. Food and Mess**

25. Meal schedules with the corresponding Menu for the Day shall be posted by the Mess Committee.
26. Meal tickets must be presented during meals (**No Meal Ticket, No Food Policy**).
27. Eating utensils will be provided by the Mess and Food Committee provided that these will be returned completely to the committee in-charge a day before the scheduled departure.
28. All participants shall be responsible in cleaning or washing their eating utensils and keep them in proper place ready to be used anytime.
29. Meals must be taken only in designated dining areas; wastage of food is discouraged.

**E. Environmental Responsibility**

29. Proper disposal of wastes must be observed at all times; waste must be placed in appropriate containers.
30. Proper waste segregation and eco-friendly practices are mandatory in line with the Eco Champions Program implemented in the WVRAA Delegation.
31. Delegation members shall participate in eco-awareness activities organized by the Eco Champions Program such as tree planting and establishment of vegetable garden in the host schools.
32. On-the-spot or unannounced ocular inspection to billeting rooms shall be conducted by the committee in-charge of cleanliness, beautification, and ECo Champions Program to ensure proper implementation in the WVRAA Delegation.



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**F. Accountability and Sanctions**

32. Any violation of the House Rules and Regulations is subject to disciplinary action.

**III. Code of Conduct**

**A. Athletes**

1. Attend all practices and competitions with commitment.
2. Show respect and sportsmanship at all times.
3. Wear official uniforms with pride and maintain decorum.
4. Observe proper nutrition, rest, and medical protocols.
5. Follow instructions from coaches and officials.

**B. Coaches and Team Managers**

1. Provide positive mentorship and discipline to athletes.
2. Exhibit fairness, professionalism, and respect in decision-making.
3. Ensure athletes meet eligibility, safety, and welfare standards.
4. Serve as role models of integrity and sportsmanship.
5. Ensure compliance with house rules.

**C. Technical Working Committees**

1. Perform assigned duties diligently and responsibly.
2. Uphold honesty, transparency, and accountability in operations.
3. Collaborate harmoniously with other committees.
4. Protect sensitive information and maintain confidentiality.
5. Exhibit professionalism in meetings, events, and engagements.

**IV. Enforcement**

1. The **Security and Discipline Committee with the Learner Rights Protection Committee** shall handle violations and recommend sanctions.
2. Sanctions may include warnings, suspension of privileges, or removal from delegation activities.
3. The **Regional Management Team and Oversight Committee** shall decide on serious cases.
4. Rules shall take effect from the departure of the WVRAA Delegation to the host region until the arrival back in Region VI.
