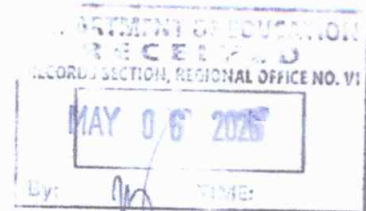

This memorandum provides technical specifications for the provision and distribution of Senior High School (SHS) Remediation Program (SRP) teaching and learning resources, in accordance with DepEd Order No. 010, s. 2026, titled "Guidelines for the Implementation of the 2026 Summer Remediation Programs (SRP)". Complete details are in **Annex A**.

The updated list of teaching and learning resources is available at: <https://tinyurl.com/SHSSummerMaterials2026>. Materials will be uploaded on a staggered, weekly basis throughout the implementation period.

Printing costs shall be charged against the FY 2025 (R.A. 12116) Textbooks and Other Instructional Materials (TBIMs) Funds, subject to allotment availability as determined by the Regional Offices and Schools Division Offices, and consistent with the applicable implementing guidelines governing the use of available fund balances.

The Regional Offices and Schools Division Offices shall ensure the timely provision and distribution of the prescribed resources based on the number of learners and tutors in each participating school implementing the SHS Remediation Program. They shall likewise exercise appropriate discretion in determining which LRs to print, ensuring that such materials are responsive to the specific needs of the program and its intended participants.
