Student participants are required to secure parental consent and waiver form for the event, participating and managing DepEd personnel are entitled to Service Credits for their services rendered during weekend and holidays but not to exceed 15 days per year in accordance with DO No. 53, s. 2023 titled “Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers. On the other hand, non-teaching personnel shall be provided with Compensatory Time Off (CTO) for their services rendered during weekends and holiday as per Civil Service Commissions (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Rendered.

The travel and other incidentals expenses of the participants, including the learners, shall be charged against local funds/MOOE and other available local funds all subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Executive Order Number 29 s. 2017 mandates the observance of the National Disaster Resilience Month (NDRM) by all Filipinos throughout the country through the conduct of activities relative to building disaster resilience. It also states the shift of focus from disaster awareness building to the promotion of significant disaster resilience which pertains to the ability of individuals, communities, organizations, and states to adapt to and recover from the effects of hazard and disasters through effective risk management.

This 2026, the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC), through the Office of Civil Defense (OCD), leads the celebration of the 38th National Disaster Resilience Month with the theme “Naghahanda at Kumikilos tungo sa Panatag na Bagong Pilipinas”.
