1. Attached is the Council Information Circular No. 07, s. 2026 from the Boy Scouts of the Philippines – Aklan Council dated May 19, 2026, regarding **Scouts' Service Activities** which is self-explanatory.

Teachers/Adult Leaders of participants are entitled to Service Credits for their services rendered during weekends and holidays but not to exceed 30 days per year in accordance with DO No. 13, s. 2024 titled "Revised Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits for Teachers. On the other hand, Non-Teaching personnel shall be granted with Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) for their services rendered during weekends and holidays as per Civil Service Commissions (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered.
3. Travel and other expenses relative to this activity may be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
4. Full support, cooperation and immediate dissemination of this memorandum is required.



SUBJECT: SCOUTS' SERVICE ACTIVITIES

1. In line to DepEd Order No. 33, s. 2008, dated May 8, 2008, titled "Responding to the Threats to Climate Change and Global Warming Through Massive, Intensive and Sustained Tree-planting, Tree-growing and Tree-caring Program" and in support to BSP National Memorandum No. 77, s. 2019, dated November 12, 2019, titled "Integration of Tree Planting Activity in All Programs and Activities of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines," this activity aims to promote environmental awareness, strengthen community participation, and instill to Scouts a sense of responsibility for caring and preserving the natural resources.
2. In this connection, the Aklan Council, Boy Scouts of the Philippines encourages all Institutional/Barangay and District/Municipal Scouting Committees to implement and support the Scouting Units especially the aspiring Eagle Scouts in their advancement requirements, "Scouts' Good Turn" as follows:
 - a. **Explorer Rank Requirement No. 15** – Together with your Crew members, plan, organize and conduct "Scout's Good Turn" habit through a School or Community Service Project.
 - b. **Pathfinder Rank Requirement No. 11** – Together with your Crew members, plan, organize and conduct "Scout's Good Turn" habits through a School or these service projects may be related to Environment, Development and Peace.
 - c. **Outdoor Scout Rank Requirement No. 11** – Identify local environment issues and propose potential solutions. Plan and execute an environmental project, understanding its connections from local to global level. Evaluate the project's impact on the Scouts, the community and the environment. Collaborate with your Crew members to plan, organize, lead and initiate, and/or actively participate in at least one environmental service project.
 - d. **Venturer Scout Rank Requirement No. 10** – Working with your Crew, plan, organize and conduct a community service project. Document the project and its impact, ensuring it aligns with one of the key areas of service: Environment, Development or Peace Education.
 - e. **Eagle Scout Rank Requirement No. 9** – Together with your Crew, plan, organize and conduct an Eagle Scout Service Project. Document the project and its impact, ensuring it contributes meaningfully to the community.
