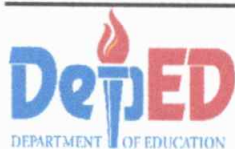

**SUBMISSION OF INTERVENTION PLAN FOR MANAGING LEARNERS'
SAFETY IN SCHOOLS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2026 - 2027**

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. In light of the recent alarming incidents involving possession of deadly weapons and firearms by the learners inside the school premises, as well as other acts that endangered the safety, protection, and well-being of learners and school personnel, this Office reiterates the importance of strengthening and enforcing existing safety and security measures within school premises.

2. The Schools Division Offices (SDOs) are hereby directed to strengthen the implementation of **DepEd Order No. 6, s. 2026, titled "Ensuring Safe and Motivating Learning Environment,"** particularly the adoption and implementation of appropriate school safety measures, including but not limited to the conduct of bag checks upon entry to school premises and other preventive mechanisms to ensure a secure and conducive learning environment.

3. Further, the SDOs are reminded of the provisions of Regional Memorandum No. 619, s. 2025 on the Submission of Intervention Plan for Managing Learners' Protection and Safety in Schools, which requires the formulation and submission of comprehensive intervention plans addressing identified concerns and risks affecting learners and personnel in schools.

4. In view of the above, all SDOs are directed to submit their respective Intervention Plans for Managing Learners' Protection and Safety in Schools for SY 2026 - 2027 **on or before June 30, 2026** through the link: **<https://tinyurl.com/2n8jd38y>**. Attached is the Intervention Plan Template for a uniform format across the Region. Likewise, SDOs shall accomplish and submit the required data/information indicated in Annex B.

5. Moreover, this Office reiterates that the submission of the Incident Report and corresponding Intervention Plan to the Regional Office shall be completed within twenty-four (24) hours after the occurrence of any incident involving learner protection and safety concerns.
