3. The conduct of the competition shall be in compliance with DepEd Order No. 009, s. 2026 or the Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education and DepEd Order No. 009, s. 2025 or the No Disruption of Classes Policy.
4. Student participants are required to secure parental consent and waiver form for the event while participating and managing DepEd personnel are entitled to Service Credits for their services rendered during weekend and holidays but not to exceed 15 days per year in accordance with DO No. 53, s. 2023 titled "Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers. On the other hand, non-teaching personnel shall be provided with Compensatory Time Off (CTO) for their services rendered during weekends and holiday as per Civil Service Commissions (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Rendered.
5. The Travel other incidentals expenses of the participants, including the learners, shall be charged against local funds/MOOE and other available local funds all subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

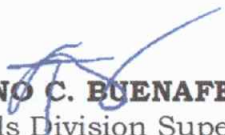
