SUBJECT : CALL FOR APPLICATIONS OF INTERESTED CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs) AND PRIVATE SECTOR FOR COUNCIL MEMBERSHIP

In line with the continuing efforts to strengthen inclusive, participatory, and community-based disaster risk reduction and management, the Regional Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council VI is hereby inviting interested Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) and private sector to apply for membership in the Council.

Pursuant to National DRRM Council Memorandum Circular No. 07 s. 2022 and Section 5 of RA 10121 the **four (4) representatives of the Civil Society Organizations** shall come from the following categories:

- 1) One (1) representative from the academe or independent research institutes;
- 2) One (1) representative from faith-based organizations;
- 3) One (1) representative from the NGOs/POs; and
- 4) One (1) representative from professional organizations, foundations or community-based organizations (CBOs)

Another one (1) representative shall come from the **Private Sector**.

Eligibility requirements for Membership:

1. Must be locally-based national or locally-organized CSOs and Private Sectors and has, amongst its members, individuals that may be deemed experts in DRRM;
2. Must provide evidence to prove its good track record and good standing as an organization particularly relative to DRRM, when applicable;
3. Must have a Letter(s) of Endorsement from a regular member(s) of the Regional DRRM Council VI;
4. The CSO and private sector organization must have an institutional structure for managing its own affairs according to its mandate, including mechanisms to effectively participate in the DRRM Council and holding its officers accountable to its members;
5. Certificate of Registration of Accreditation;
6. CSO and Private Sector applicants who are proven in court to have been engaged in aiding, providing support, promoting and financing, among others, terrorism as defined by RA 10168 otherwise known as "The Terrorism Financing Prevention and Suppression Act" as well as in RA 11479 or "The Anti-Terrorism Act of 2020" shall be ineligible;
7. Applicants for a seat in the Council that have participated in any election as party-list representatives to the Philippine Congress shall be ineligible to apply for any seat.

Documentary Requirements for Application:

1. Duly accomplished Application for Membership Form (can be accessed through <https://link.dev/jgkks01>)

2. Letter of Intent (LOI) addressed to the Chairperson indicating a brief background of the organization and activities of the Council in which it wishes to participate;
3. The Application Form and LOI shall be accompanied by the following documents:
 - A. Certificate of Registration or Accreditation issued by any of the following government agencies:
 - Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC)
 - Cooperatives Development Authority (CDA)
 - Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE)
 - Any government agency empowered by law or policy to issue such registration or accreditation, such as, but not limited to:
 - o Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD)
 - o Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD)
 - o Department of Health (DOH)
 - o Department of Education (DepEd)
 - o National Commission on Indigenous Peoples (NCIP)
 - o National Anti-Poverty Commission (NAPC)
 - o Insurance Commission
 - o Professional Regulation Commission (PRC)
 - B. In the case of networks, a Memorandum of Cooperation, undertaken by its members forming said networks, as the case may be, and the Certificate of Registration or Accreditation of the organization of its duly designated representative;
 - C. Authenticated copy of latest Articles of Incorporation showing the original incorporators and its By-Laws accompanied by a Secretary's Certificate identifying the names of its incumbent offices;
 - D. For networks, the authenticated Articles of Incorporation and Secretary's Certificate of its designated representative would suffice;
 - E. Financial reports, audited by an Independent Certified Public Accountant and signed by the officers of the organization, covering the period it has been in operation, indicating therein the source/s of funds, if any;
 - F. For networks, the said Financial Reports of its designated representative would suffice;
 - G. Letter(s) of Endorsement from a regular member(s) of the Council;
 - H. Certificate of good track record and good standing as an organization

Interested CSOs/private sector organizations are enjoined to submit hard copies of the documentary requirements to the Office of Civil Defense VI located at Camp Delgado, Fort San Pedro, Iloilo City. Soft copies may also be sent to the RDRRC VI Secretariat through email at rdrmc6secretariat@gmail.com with subject **Application for RDRRC VI Membership**. The deadline of submission is on **31 July 2026**.
