**APPRAISING SCHOOL HEADS ACADEMY (SHA) SCHOLARS AND ONSITE
VALIDATION OF THE RE-ENTRY APPLICATION PROJECT (REAP)**

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 339, s. 2021, the School Heads Academy requires the implementation of the School Heads Academy Re-Entry Application Project (SHA-REAP) as the major program requirement for scholars prior to the completion of the academy and Regional Memorandum No. 029, s. 2026 titled Re-entry Application Project (REAP) Validation of the School Heads Academy (SHA) Scholars of DepEd Region VI – Cohort 2, this office announces the schedule of SDO Aklan for the SHA-REAP Validation for SHA Cohort 2 Scholars on August 7, 2026 from 8:00 am to 12:00 nn at Ati-Atihan Festival Hotel, 19 Martyrs St, Kalibo, Aklan and onsite at the selected scholar station.
2. The objectives of this training are the following:
 - a. ensure that the projects of the scholars are implemented in accordance with the approved execution plan;
 - b. determine the immediate result of the projects to the identified beneficiaries;
 - c. assess the leadership and managerial competence of the scholars in school setting; and
 - d. provide further inputs for the projects' sustainability.
3. The participants to this activity are the SHA Batch 2 Scholars, Division SHA Committee members, and the DepEd RO VI validators.
4. In the morning, each scholar shall have a 5 to 7-minute video presentation, showcasing the over-all design and implementation of the project. A question-and answer portion by the validators will follow to clarify some issues/gray areas in the implementation and to reiterate the strengths of the project and the notable practices of the scholars. These will last for 15 to 20 minutes per scholar.
5. Attached are the list of SHA scholars and Division SHA Committee members for reference and guidelines on the validation of the SHA-REAP of the SHA Batch 2 Scholars.



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6. The SHA Scholars are advised to bring their SHA-REAP presentations for review and critiquing.
7. Travel and other incidental expenses of the personnel concerned shall be charged against HRTD Fund, subject to the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
