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(RMEA) mechanisms to enhance organizational performance, accountability, and continuous improvement.

3. Specifically, the activity seeks to:
 - a. deepen participants' understanding of the Basic Education Monitoring and Evaluation Framework (BEMEF) and its principles, processes, and tools;
 - b. enhance participants' competencies in preparing Implementation Plans and Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) Plans aligned with organizational goals, performance indicators, and expected outputs;
 - c. strengthen participants' knowledge and skills in the conduct of Program Implementation Review and Performance Assessment (PIRPA) and Regional Monitoring, Evaluation, and Adjustment (RMEA);
 - d. promote evidence-based planning, monitoring, evaluation, reporting, and decision-making through the effective utilization of monitoring and performance data; and
 - e. ensure the consistent implementation of BEMEF and the institutionalization of PIRPA–RMEA mechanisms in schools and offices across the Division.
4. The participants to this activity are the following:
 - Education Program Supervisors;
 - Public Schools District Supervisors/Principal/Head Teacher-in-Charge of the District;
 - Senior/Education Program Specialists;
 - Division Unit/Section Heads;
 - Division Focal Persons/Program Handlers;
 - Division Internal Monitors; and
 - Public Elementary, Secondary, and Integrated School Heads.
5. The activity shall be conducted online through Microsoft Teams. The meeting link, program of activities, and other pertinent details shall be communicated to all participants prior to the scheduled activity.
6. Guidelines in the submission of Implementation Plans and Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) Plans, consistent with the BEMEF and PIRPA–RMEA requirements will be issued in a separate memorandum.

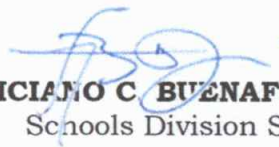


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7. Attendance and active participation of all concerned are hereby enjoined.
