**SUBMISSION OF REPORTED CASES FOR PREVENTION AND MANAGEMENT
OF DENGUE AND LEPTOSPIROSIS**

1. Attached is Regional Memorandum No. 929, s. 2026 dated September 15, 2026 regarding **Submission of Reported Cases for Prevention and Management of Dengue and Leptospirosis**, which is self-explanatory.
2. School heads, in coordination with school health personnel and the concerned local health authorities, shall ensure the following:
 - a. Monitor and validate any suspected or confirmed dengue and leptospirosis cases in the school;
 - b. Prepare and submit a report indicating the number of cases (if any), name of affected school, age group affected, date of onset, actions taken, and number of referred cases to local health units; and
 - c. conduct advocacy/health talks on the prevention and management of cases in schools and at home.
3. The initial submission of data will be **on or before September 18, 2026**, with monthly updates every end of the month thereafter until further notice. For schools with no reported cases, a "No Case" report must still be submitted to ensure completeness of monitoring.
4. School heads are directed to ensure the timely consolidation and submission of complete and accurate reports to the Division Office through the designated health personnel/focal person. The consolidated data shall be used for appropriate monitoring and reporting to the Regional Office.

**SUBMISSION OF REPORTED CASES FOR PREVENTION AND MANAGEMENT
OF DENGUE AND LEPTOSPIROSIS**

To: School Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. In light of the recent health advisories and the potential increase in the incidence of dengue and the leptospirosis in various parts of the country, this Office directs the Schools Division Offices for the submission of reports of dengue and leptospirosis cases among the school learners and personnel in their respective areas of responsibility.
2. Dengue and leptospirosis is a viral illness commonly affecting young children, characterized by sudden high fever, chills and severe fatigue that if untreated may lead to fatality.
3. In this regard, all Schools Division Offices (SDOs) shall coordinate with the school heads, school health personnel, and local health authorities to:
 - a. monitor and validate any suspected or confirmed dengue and leptospirosis cases in schools;
 - b. submit a report indicating the number of cases (if any), name of affected schools, age group affected, date of onset, actions taken, and number of referred cases to local health units; and
 - c. conduct advocacy/health talks on the prevention and management of cases in schools and at home.
4. The initial submission of data will be **on or before September 18, 2026**, with monthly updates every end of the month thereafter until further notice. For schools or divisions with no reported cases, a "No Case" report must still be submitted to ensure completeness of monitoring.
5. The initial data submitted by the SDOs will be consolidated by this office to be presented during the Regional Management Committee Meeting (RMANCOM) for the month of September 2026.
