**ADOPTION OF THE CONTEXTUALIZED CONTINGENCY PLAN FOR
MANAGING LEARNERS' PROTECTION AND SAFETY
IN SCHOOLS AND OFFICES IN REGION VI**

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. Pursuant to Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010," and Republic Act No. 11036, otherwise known as the "Mental Health Act," and consistent with the mandate of the Department of Education to ensure the safety, protection, and well-being of learners, this Office, through the Education Support Services Division (ESSD), hereby issues the **Contextualized Contingency Plan (CCP) for Managing Learners' Protection and Safety in Schools and Offices in Region VI.**

2. The CCP is a regional framework developed primarily to guide schools and offices in the protection, safety, and well-being of learners, while recognizing the roles and responsibilities of school personnel and other concerned stakeholders in preparedness, response, coordination, and recovery. It provides a systematic and coordinated approach in managing various risks, hazards, and emerging situations that may adversely affect learners and guides education personnel and concerned stakeholders in implementing appropriate measures based on their respective contexts.

3. This recognizes the varying risk profiles and operational contexts of schools and offices across the region. It provides a common framework for identifying potential threats and vulnerabilities, establishing response protocols, clarifying roles and responsibilities of various stakeholders, and strengthening coordination among DepEd offices, schools, learners, parents, communities, and relevant external partners.

4. All SDOs are directed to facilitate the adoption, implementation and orientation of the CCP to all schools and offices within their respective divisions. Schools shall likewise review and enhance their existing contingency and safety mechanisms based on the identified risks, available

resources, and local conditions, while ensuring alignment with existing DepEd policies and relevant national and local protocols.

5. The SDOs shall monitor the implementation of the CCP and consolidate issues, challenges, notable practices, and recommendations arising from its adoption and implementation and shall be one of the discussion agenda during the conduct of Program Implementation Review (PIR) of the ESSD.

7. This Office shall provide technical assistance to SDOs in the initial implementation of the plan through the conduct of an online orientation to all program handlers to be announced in a separate memorandum.
